When I get to the museum, I will need to check-in at the Welcome Desk.

My grown up will check-in with me at the counter.





Before I start playing, I may want to go to the bathroom. The bathrooms are down a hallway past the Welcome Desk.



We will walk past the gift shop and many colorful displays.

I can take off my shoes and put them in a cubby and take off my coat and hang it up too!



It can be loud in the Museum. If I think the Museum is going to be too loud, I can borrow headphones.

If I need a Quiet Place, I can ask my adult if I can go to the Nurture Room.



If I get lost or have a question, I can find one of the grown ups wearing a lanyard with their name on it and ask for help. They are there to make sure I am safe and having fun!

I can play with the big blue blocks.

If I am under 5, I can play in Little Explorers.



I can participate in a daily program in the Learning Lab.



If it's nice outside, my grown-up and I can play in the museum's courtyard. There is a pollinator garden where I can see plants that bees, butterflies and other pollinators enjoy!
